From these earliest beginnings, Bermuda has maintained close ties with the United States. With the sea surrounding them, and a plentiful supply of cedar for shipbuilding, Bermuda soon became a trading nation and an important strategic base for Britain's Royal Navy. During the Revolution, Bermudians smuggled gunpowder to the Continental Army, and during the Civil War, St. George's was an important port for blockade runners taking goods in and out of the South.

The history of the 18th and 19th centuries is still vividly presented in the abundant historic architecture on the island.

Symmetrical and graceful Georgian houses, characterized by whitewashed coral limestone, steeply pitched roofs, and large chimneys, provide an interesting contrast to American colonial architecture. Bermuda-made cedar furniture and paneling echo English styles of the period. There will

be a time to simply enjoy the relaxed and gracious atmosphere of this enchanted island where narrow lanes, winding roads, and neatly tended gardens blend easily with pink sand and turquoise sea.

The weather is just beautiful in early November. The average high is 74°F during the day, but cooler in the evening. Since the days are warm, lightweight clothing is appropriate. A light sweater or jacket for the cooler evenings is also in order. Pack your Bermuda shorts. The ocean is still warm and The Princess has a beautiful heated swimming pool regardless of the outside temperature.

The Bermuda dollar is pegged to the US dollar, so you will not have money exchange problems for your pre-holiday shopping.

Plus this is a great opportunity to get your Christmas shopping done as the area contains numerous working artists' studios (painting, weaving, sculpture) and a craft market where local Bermuda artisans produce and sell their products. #### Day 3, Wednesday, 9 November


Today we board our deluxe motor coach for a driving tour of Hamilton to see Fort Hamilton. As we will travel east our first stop is a visit to the magnificent
