



IWO JIMA DAY

Each March since 1995 veterans, historians, and bereaved family members from both the US and Japan gather for one day on the island formerly known as Iwo Jima, now Iwo To, to honor the valor and sacrifice from servicemen from both sides of the battle. The focus of the trip is the solemn Memorial Service. Iwo To is equivalent to Arlington as many from both sides are still entombed on the island. For this reason this event is separated from our advertised tours and is a separate event.

There are several requirements for participation:

- 1. A coat and tie is mandatory. The bereaved families will be in funeral attire.
- 2. You must be a member of the Iwo Jima Association of America.
- 3. There will be minimum support on the island, so you must be able to walk from the airplane to the reunion site. We have no guarantee of transportation but if we do it will be minimal. You will be required to sign a hold harmless which attests to this. Only WWII veterans and their escorts are guaranteed transportation.
- 4. Boarding passes will be issued after the Friday symposium, but you must present your IJAA membership card and sign the hold harmless agreement to receive the boarding pass. You will be required to attend a safety briefing on Friday prior to receiving your boarding pass.

Additional information:

- 1. If you are on the Guam tour the trip to Iwo will be seamless and has a day built into the tour to go to Iwo.
- 2. If you do not participate on the Guam tour since you live on or are already on Guam, you may attend the banquet on Thursday night, attend the symposium, and attend the fiesta.
- 3. If you are in the US and only want to attend The Reunion Of Honor and not tour Guam with the group, you will still have to spend at least three (3) or four (4) days on Guam. You would depart the US on Wednesday, lose a day crossing the International Date Line, and arrive on Thursday evening, missing the banquet. Friday you would attend the symposium and safety briefing, and receive your boarding pass. Fly to Iwo on Saturday, returning in the

evening. You may opt to fly out the next morning, but you must be at the airport around 4AM. If you decide to stay Sunday, you will have a chance to adjust your body clock and attend the symposium. If, however, you decide to tough it out you will need a couple of down days when you get home. The flight is long and requires a plane change in either Honolulu or Tokyo.

- 4. A 3 day stay on Guam is \$900 and 4 day stay is \$1200 and includes breakfast each day.
