






# VIETNAM POST TOURS

## Dien Bien Phu Post Tour Itinerary

Travel back to the epic French gamble in Indochina where the Viet Minh's siege had drastic consequences for the French Foreign Legionnaires, paratroopers, and colonial troops. Cost \$1200.00 (BODO-Based On Double Occupancy)

Single Room Supplement \$250

Day One: This morning we transfer to Hanoi's Noi Bai Airport for the flight to Dien Bien Phu landing at the same airfield the French used during the siege. Upon arrival, we will drive to the Muong Thanh Hotel for check in. After lunch, we begin our exploration of the battlefield with a visit to the Dien Bien Phu Military Museum to familiarize ourselves with the siege by studying the course of the



battle using maps and sand tables. We continue on to see Hill A-1 and Independence Hill. Hotel: Muong Thanh (B/L/D)

Day Two: We start our day with a visit to Noong Nhai village. We continue on to see a tribal village at Him Lam and some of the northern Vietnamese culture. After lunch, we stop at Pa Khoang Lake and walk some of the battlefield including the crater from the massive sapper charge used against the French strongpoint Elaine 2. The day culminates with a stop at General Giap's Command Post. Hotel: Muong Thanh (B/L/D)

Day Three: Our final morning starts with a visit to the Dien Bien Phu Cemetery, the Monument to the Vietnamese victory and Col De Castrie's bunker before transferring to the airport for our flight to Hanoi. Upon arrival we transfer to our hotel with some free time after lunch in Hanoi. We

check out at and transfer to the airport for an evening departure and arrive in the USA the next morning. # **ADDITIONAL POST TOURS**

## Cambodia Angkor Vietnam Post Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Hanoi—Siem Reap - Arrival. Pick up from hotel in Hanoi and transfer to airport for flight. Upon arrival in Siem Reap, meet and transfer to hotel for check in. Visit to the unique interior brick sculptures of Prasat Kravan, Srah Srang ("The Royal Baths"), Banteay Kdei (surrounded by 4 concentric walls), **Ta Prohm**, one of the area's most beautiful temples. Ta Prohm has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Neak Pean, a fountain built in the middle of a pool (representing the paradisiacal Himalayan mountain-lake) and Preah Khan Temple. Hotel: Tara Angkor (D)

Day 2: Siem Reap Tour. In the morning, visit the antique capital of Angkor Thom (12 century), the South Gate with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of the Bayon Temple, unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King. Lunch at local restaurant followed by visits to the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: Angkor Wat, this huge temple complex which is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer

art and architecture. Then we continue to visit some of the Khmer Rouge Genocide sites: minefield, the Killing 📷 Fields, and Arms Museum. We then continue to view a wonderful sunset from **Pre Rup Temple.** Dinner at local restaurant before returning to our hotel. Hotel: Tara Angkor (B/L/D)

Day 3: Siem Reap - Hanoi Today we board on boat in Tonle Sap Lake, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia, one of the largest in Asia. We enjoy a brief cruise past **floating villages** complete with schools, restaurants, markets and hospitals. Lunch at local restaurant. Then transfer to Siem Reap Airport for flight to Hanoi. Hotel: Silk Path (B/L)

Day 4: Departure. Transfer from hotel to airport for flight to take connecting flight to US from Hanoi. (B)

## Laos Vietnam Post Tour Itinerary

**Day 1:** Arrival – Luang Prabang. A/C car pick up guest from hotel in Hanoi and transfer to Noi Bai airport for flight to Luang Prabang International Airport for transfer to your hotel. After you have had time to rest and freshen up we will head off to see some of the highlights of Luang Prabang including a visit to the Royal Palace Museum, which hosts a range of interesting artifacts from the Royal period. Next is the city's oldest temples, the magnificent Wat Xiengthong with its classical Lao architecture, the impressive stupa of Wat Visoun and the shrine of Wat Aham. From there we will climb to the top of Mount Phousi to explore the sacred gilded stupa and to enjoy the panoramic view of the city and the sun set-ting over the Mekong River. As we descend the mountain your will find yourself in the midst of the famous Luang Prabang Night Market, find a unique selection of handmade textiles and handicrafts locally made by both ethnic Lao and hill tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang. Hotel: VILLA SANTI\*\*\*\* (L/D)

Day2: Luang Prabang - Pak Ou cave - Khouangsi Waterfall. This morning you have the option to rise early and participate in the daily morning ritual of Alms Giving, you will experience saffron-clad monks collecting offerings or 'Alms' from faithful local residents. This tradition is unique to Laos, being the only Buddhist nation still preserving the daily procession. After breakfast back at the hotel, we begin our journey to Khouangsi Waterfall stopping along the way to visit the morning Phousi Market, this where all locals of Luang Drohoming are to do their daily appring. Prabang come to do their daily shopping. You will see a variety of local foodstuffs and products including dried buffalo skin, local tea and saltpeter among everything needed for





daily life in Laos. On arrival at the Khouangsi Waterfall you will have the opportunity to cool off with a refreshing swim in the topaz pools below the falls, walk along the forest trails and visit the Bear Sanctuary. You will also enjoy a picnic lunch below the falls. Upon return to Luang Prabang we board our private boat for a pleasant and scenic cruise up on the Mekong River to the mysterious Pak Ou Caves. These caves are an ancient pilgrimage site and contain thousands of gold lacquered Buddha images left there over hundreds of years. Returning to Luang Prabang we disembark our boat and have the option of taking a short drive to Ban Phanom, a village famous for its hand weaving. Dinner with dance show at Tamnak Lao restaurant **Hotel: VILLA SANTI\*\*\*\* (B/L/D)** 

**Day 3: Luang Prabang –HANOI.** This morning is free until transfer to the airport for your departure flight to HANOI. A/C car pick up from Noi Bai airport and transfer to Silk Path for check in **Hotel: SILK PATH**\*\*\*\*/deluxe (B)

Day 4: DEPARTURE. This morning is free until a/c car transfer to the airport for your departure flight back home. (B)
