



Wake Island — a battle both remembered and lamented as one of the greatest battles of the War in the Pacific. Though the island fell to the overwhelming forces of the Japanese invasion fleet in late December, the "Magnificent Fight" exhibited by the Marines, Sailors, Soldiers and Civilians in December 1941 against overwhelming odds stands as one of the epic struggles in the annals of warfare and the only time in WWII an amphibious invasion was tossed back into the sea.

Pearl Harbor — we return on the "Date Which Will Live in Infamy" the surprise Japanese attack that launched the USA into World War II.

**Guam** — We will also commemorate the Japanese invasion of Guam one day earlier and the efforts of the 274 sailors and 153 Marines of that island's garrison. Join us as we travel to Hawaii, Guam and Wake Island to commemorate the 81st Anniversaries of these early World War II battles in the Pacific.
